

The 14th International Symposium on Magnetic Bearings ISMB14

Linz, AUSTRIA August 11-14, 2014

Organized by the ACCM Austrian Center of Competence in Mechatronics

The International Symposium on Magnetic Bearings is the oldest and nowadays, the most important conference series on magnetic bearings. It succeeded in bringing together magnetic bearing experts from all over the world in order to present and discuss new results and trends in magnetic bearing technologies and to act as a stimulus for intensifying magnetic bearing approaches in research and product development.

In this event, the industrial implementation of magnetic bearing technology shall be given proper space without loosing sight of the approved scientific accents. The involvement of industry shall be particularly stimulated by mini-symposia devoted to magnetic bearing problems, especially in a mechatronic sense, and to application examples.

- Passive magnetic bearings (PMB)
- Hybrid bearing systems
- Bearingless motors
- Smart bearings
- Industrial applications

- Power electronics for magnetic bearings
- Modelling, simulation, design and verification
- Advanced control
- Rotor dynamics
- Fault detection and diagnosis

Mini-Symposia

Mini-symposia within the conference can be proposed for any topic related directly or indirectly to magnetic bearing technology; organizers are requested to compose their mini-symposium in close coordination with the conference chairs. The review of the mini-symposia contributions will be coordinated by the respective organizer.

Publication of Selected Papers in Peer-Reviewed Journals

Authors of ISMB14 conference papers recommended during the review process will be invited to submit extended versions for journal publication. These works will undergo a separate journal review process.

Venue

The conference will be held at the campus of the Johannes Kepler University in Linz. The university, which is particularly renowned for its engineering department, was the first to introduce a full mechatronics curriculum at university level worldwide. The campus is nicely situated in the northern part

of Linz bordering the picturesque region "Mühlviertel" and can be conveniently reached by public transport (tramway) from the city centre.

Linz (population ~200.000) is the capital of Upper Austria ("Oberösterreich"), a highly dynamic state with respect to technology and industry, tourism, and culture. Linz was the European Capital of Culture in 2009 and is an attractive city with scenic surroundings. The latter include the Salzkammergut (~1h trip from Linz), which offers many leisure opportunities with its numerous lakes and mountains.

Other major Austrian cities including Vienna and Salzburg can be conveniently reached by train.

Organized Sightseeing Tours

Two beautiful optional tours are organized within the conference program schedule to discover attractions of the city of Linz and historical und scenic sites of Upper Austria (a one-day tour on August 11th before the welcome-reception and a one-day tour on August 15th after the conference).
